2-up 25 mile team time trial – 10th March 2018



Promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials - Under its rules and regulations

Safety - not your performance - is the first priority

Hosted by - Hitchin Nomads CC as a Club Time Trial (a CTT "Type B" event)

Signing on and numbers - will be available from 0830h to 0915h at the start line for preregistered competitors. Registration on the day will be permitted at the discretion of the organiser and in no circumstances after 0845h. Please check that a correct emergency contact number is listed when you sign, and address for non-members of HNCC.

Teams - For any team where one rider is unable to ride, the other rider will be permitted to ride as a "solo" but is no longer an eligible competitor for the Club 2-up competition. Teams not comprising two HNCC members can ride but are also ineligible for the competition and will be recorded as "Private Time Trial" (PTT). If two teams are a rider short then it might be possible to create a new 2-up team on the day but this is not guaranteed. It is possible that start times and team formations will be needed to be adjusted at the last minute, and riders are asked to be flexible on this. If any start times vary by more than by a very few minutes then every effort will be made to contact those affected prior to the event.

Headquarters - there is no Event HQ. Riders and event crew will most likely convene at the Shuttleworth Café after the event, where the results will be shared (please do not bother the Timekeepers at the Finish Line by asking for your time there). There is usually plenty of parking for customers at the café.

Parking - DO NOT park on the course. The informal lay by at the start line should only be used for parking by event officials. Ride out or share transport if you are able to. Suggest meeting on the Market Square in Hitchin for 07:45. There is plenty of parking on the verge along the lane from Southill to Old Warden (by the start of the "Briercliffe 10" course), and in the village of Southill (e.g. the car park opposite the school) but be respectful of local residents. Keep the noise to a minimum and absolutely no use of turbos within the village please.

£2.00 entry fee per rider for Club members to cover CTT levy and event costs. Private Time Trials (i.e. non-members) £4. Cash only – IOUs will not be accepted. Riders whose Club membership has expired will count as PTTs.

Event Crew — Nick Hickman will arrange course signage and on-the-day check. He will manage sign-on with David Rossall. Leanne Cutler is Principal Timekeeper with Mark Young as Assistant. Props (pushing riders off) are Simon Young and others to be confirmed. Michael Webb is Event Photographer.

Riding a 2-up Team Time Trial

2-up teams and any solo riders are set off at 2-minute intervals at *x* minutes past the hour, where *x* is the highest rider number of the pair. The time for a team is that of the second rider crossing the finish line. Please call out your numbers, which should be worn as low as possible - on your bum ideally, not the centre of your back.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Rider Behaviour

Please be aware that there has been occasional friction between some residents of Old Warden village and the cycling community. Riders are therefore reminded of CTT regulations in this regard, and that they "shall not act or behave in a manner such as to give offence to the public interest or such as to bring the sport into disrepute". Competitors must observe the law and:

- (a) not ride in a manner that is unsafe either to themselves or to other road users;
- (b) ride on the left-hand side of the road except for safe overtaking and when making right hand turns:
- (c) conform to all traffic signs, signals and direction indicators;
- (d) in making any turn before, during or after the event, ensure that it is safe to do so.

Legal Stuff

This event is approved by CTT London North District. CTT is the governing body for Cycling Time Trials in England and Wales. Bedfordshire Police have acknowledged receipt of a notification for the event. HNCC is covered by CTT's 3rd Party Liability Insurance (this policy protects the Club and its event crew, not the riders). Riders are advised to review the risk assessment for the course, which has been recently reviewed and lodged with CTT. An "on the day" course check will be carried out and riders will be alerted to any hazards.

Course

Cycling Event signs will be in place at key points on and near to the course. These are to alert other road users to the event and do not necessarily indicate the route of the course. It is hoped that direction arrows will also be set up, but riders should not rely on these. It is YOUR sole responsibility to navigate the course, which will <u>not</u> be marshalled. The course uses some small country lanes. There are pot holes, loose surfaces and standing water in some places. The main B658 road from Shefford to the G&M Growers roundabout has some significant pot holes before and in Stanford, and at the Broom Crossroads. These have all been reported to the Highways Team of Central Bedfordshire Council although it is not guaranteed that any repairs will be made before this event. Any that are not fixed will be marked up with white painted chevrons.



- 1. START on south side of unclassified road Ireland-Southill at field boundary (GR 141413).
- 2. Proceed west to triangle where left and downhill to junction with A600 where left into Shefford and then left on to B658.
- 3. Continue over mini roundabout and follow through Broom cross roads (4.5m) to GM Growers RAB where left to Old Warden.
- 4. Continue through village, past Southill-Old Warden and Cardington junctions to disused railway bridge where left uphill and left at junction to triangle (10.7m) where left over hump back bridge.
- 5. Continue and take first left through Southill village to Broom cross roads (12.7m) where left onto B658.
- 6. Repeat circuit via Broom cross roads (20.9m) and continue to GM Growers and Old Warden to Southill-Old Warden junction where left to FINISH at GR 142433
